






Master Bedroom








My parents were struggling with the chaos and stress of their laundry room. All their cleaning supplies and my dad's clothes closet had to be accommodated within the room as well.

Most of my furniture is secondhand and curated over several years. I have restyled or replaced pieces I find to make a living room that is comfortable and fun.


